

PAOLO ROSSI CASTELLI

Journalist since 1983, Paolo Rossi Castelli is a specialist of scientific publishing and divulgation, especially about medicine and biology. He created Sportello Cancro (Cancer Window), an area of corriere.it (Corriere della Sera) dedicated to oncology and realized in collaboration with Umberto Veronesi Foundation. He has been writing for several years for Corriere della Sera and for Sette about science. He has been in the central office of a scientific magazine, Ok Salute, published by RCS – Rizzoli Corriere della Sera, and of its website. He was author of Macchina del Tempo, tv programme about nature, environment, science and history, broadcasted on Rete 4, and he worked as consultant for several Mediaset productions. He was scientific consultant for DeA Sapere (De Agostini's channel broadcasted on Sky platform), news editor in SaluteBenessere Channel (Sole 24 Ore), and author for SeiMilano, experimental channel owned by Benetton Group. He's expert also in newspapers, both classical (Italia Oggi) and online: he managed culture and health areas of Nuovo.it, one of the first online newspapers in Italy (e.Biscom group). He wrote for many important magazines, such as Panorama, Epoca, Il Mondo. Now he's President of Fondazione per la Scienza in Lugano and editor in chief of Assedio Bianco, (www.assediobianco.ch), website specialized on immunology. He writes for Corriere del Ticino about science.
